

## VAN MAHOTSAV

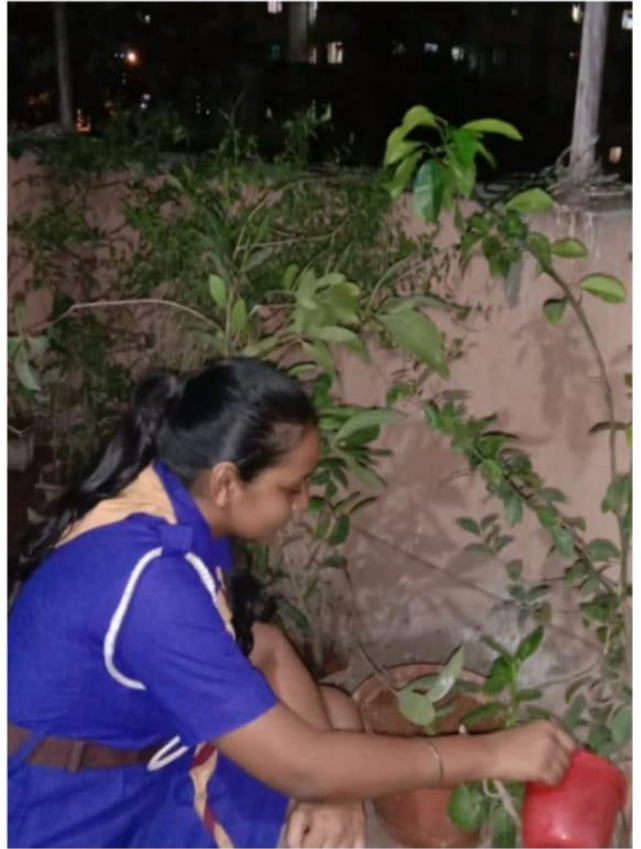
“Trees are the kindest things we grow”. This has been rightly said as the needs of all the living beings are fulfilled by them”.
