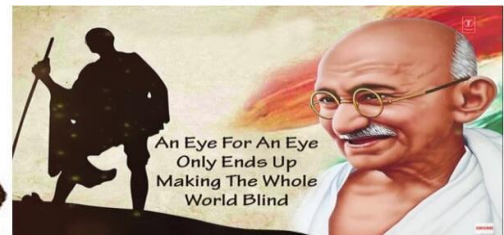


Gandhi Jayanti and Feast of St. Therese

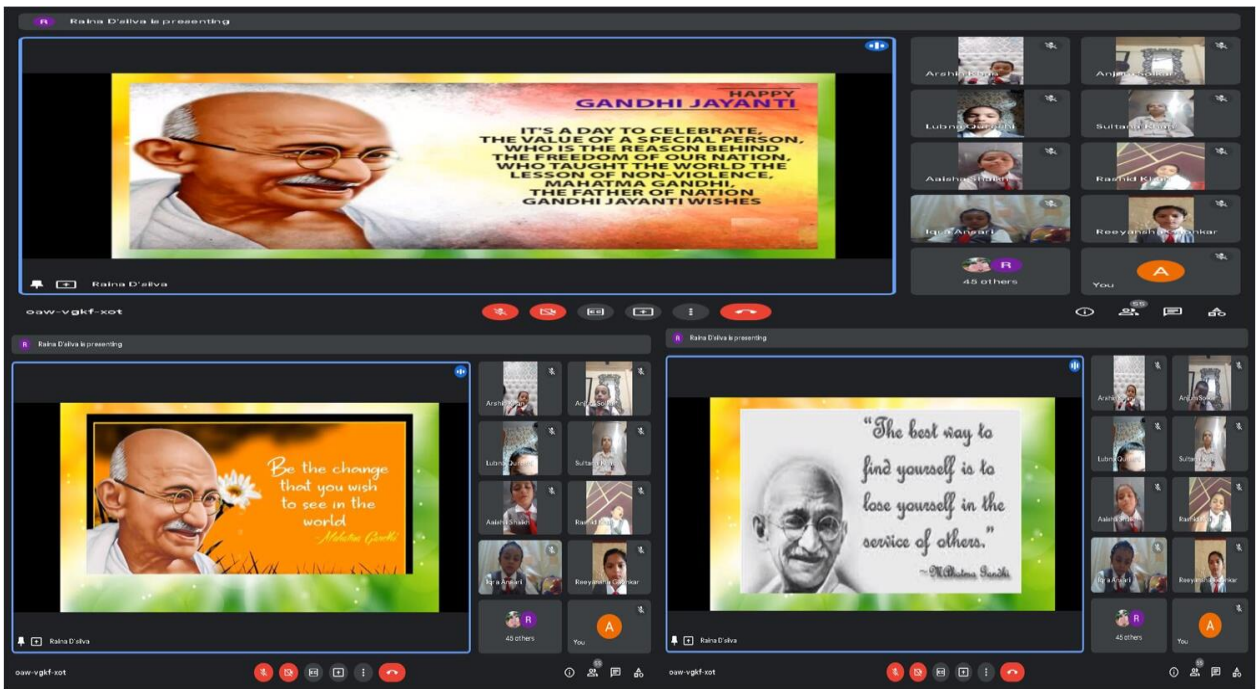
Marie- Francoise- Therese Martin was born on January 2, 1873 and baptized two days later on January 4th, "All my life God surrounded me with love".

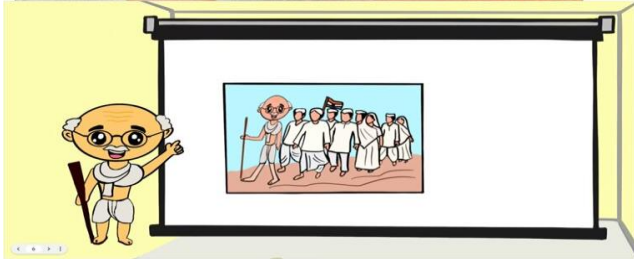
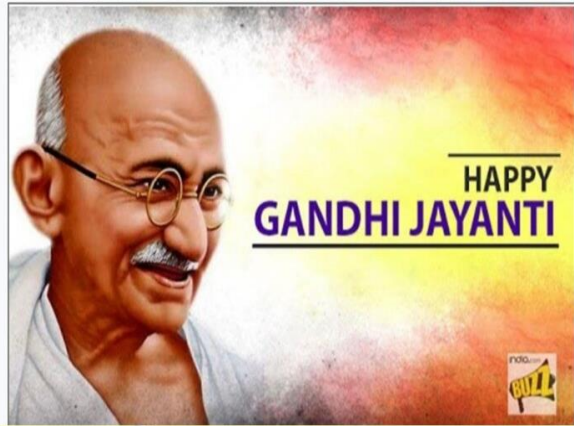
