Junior college admission rules

1. Admission to the F.Y.J.C. will be as per the online system introduced by Government of Maharashtra / Dy. Director of Education, Greater Mumbai. Hence students are expected to visit the site.

2. Students are hereby informed that the original school leaving certificate will be kept with the college as a permanent record and will not be returned to them. Students are advised to keep with them sufficient number of attested photo copies of the School Leaving Certificate for future use. The School Leaving certificate once submitted to the college will not be returned.

3. Students from other board /States/Countries seeking admission to the F.Y.J.C. (std.XI) should submit all the relevant certificates and the necessary undertaking in order to obtain a Provisional Eligibility Certificate from the Mumbai Divisional Board. Kindly note that the admission granted to the students coming from other boards are not final until the Eligibility Certificate is issued by the concerned authorities. (Any fines, late fees, etc. to the Board will be Borne by the student.)

4. A student taking admission in std. XI is considered as taking admission for 2 years (i.e. std. XI and XII).

5. Admission to Arts, Science and Commerce streams will be given through online process.

ELIGIBILITY

Students who belong to other board (CBSE, ICSE, NIOS, IGCSE and other Board) are required to submit the following documents (At the time of admission tentatively, by the last week of August)

- One photocopy of Statement of marks of Std X Examination
- One photocopy of Passing certificate / provisional passing certificate of the last public examination.
- One photocopy of School Leaving Certificate / Transfer Certificate / Transcript (With counter signature by appropriate education authority in the relevant case).
- Migration Certificate in Original.
- Deed of undertaking (On a Rs 100/- stamp paper)
- Marks Conversion Sheet for Graded Marksheets only.
- Certificate in the prescribed Appendix "A" (for candidates coming from outside India and desire of seeking admission in the junior college, situated in the state of Maharashtra under the jurisdiction of the board)
